PRESS RELEASE

The Arunachal Pradesh Staff Selection Board (APSSB) is conducting the Combined Higher Secondary Level (CHSL) Examination on 03rd October 2021, the advertisement for which was notified on 10th May 2021.

The APSSB has endeavored to bring in effective and systemic improvements through updations in the SOPs to ensure that the exam process is carried out smoothly in a default-free manner.

The Board had initially notified 179 number of posts of LDC, Data Entry Operator, JSA, Agriculture Field Assistant (Jr), Laboratory Assistant, Record Keeper / Record Clerk / Computer Operator (APST: 154, Unreserved: 24 and PwD: 01). 01 additional vacancy from APIC and 02 vacancies from District Establishment of West Siang District were received subsequently. Accordingly, the total vacancies now is 182 (APST: 157, Unreserved: 24 and PwD: 01).

Total 37770 candidates have applied for the above posts and 27239 candidates have downloaded admit cards till 5 pm on 01.10.2021. Admit cards can be downloaded from APSSB web portal till 11:59 PM on 02nd October 2021.

The Board has made elaborate arrangements for smooth conduct of the examination which is being conducted across 130 venues in 12 districts including Itanagar Capital Region. More than 4500 exam functionaries have been engaged in the exercise. Besides, 28 Observers, 36 Coordinators, 12 Deputy Commissioners, 12 SPs and 12 Nodal Officers have also been engaged in the entire process for supervision, coordination and smooth conduct.

The Board has also deployed Police Personnel across all centres with senior police officers supervising the security arrangements. There will be no entry to the venue without admit card, frisking of candidates and capturing of biometrics. **Candidates with even-ending roll numbers are directed to come between 07:00 – 08:00 AM and those with odd-ending roll numbers are directed to come between 08:00 – 09:00 AM** to avoid crowding at biometric and frisking counters.

Carrying of mobile phones and electronic gadgets are strictly prohibited. As a preventive measure to stop use of unfair means / malpractices, all mobile internet service providers have been directed to suspend the mobile internet services only from 09:30 AM to 01:00 PM on 03.10.2021 at respective townships. Therefore, the candidates are advised not to risk their future by bringing prohibited items inside examination halls. Strict legal action will be taken including lodging of FIR & debarment from future examinations of APSSB if candidates are found using any type of unfair means during examination. Local Police has been directed by the Board to do strict checking & frisking and take legal action including lodging of FIR against the defaulters.

The candidates appearing in the examination are advised to go through all the instructions and advisory issued by the Board from time to time. The instructions on the e-Admit Card should be complied with to avoid any inconvenience. Executive Magistrates and flying squads are also deployed to ensure quick action if any candidate is found indulging in any form of cheating or malpractice.

All District Superintendents / Deputy Commissioners have been asked to ensure that Covid appropriate behavior is followed by everyone involved in the conduct of examinations including the candidates.

The Board extends best wishes to all candidates and functionaries for successful conduct of the examination.
